#### 3.9 Areas of concern around the Town

❖ <u>Number 49</u> – Usk Town Council (UTC) has received complaints about Number 49 placing signage and other marketing obstacles on the public footpath area opposite the Co-op Store, greatly narrowing the walkway.

❖ **No Mow May** – objections & complaints have been raised about uncut verges and in particular the Owain Glyndwr field.

**Resolved:** UTC to contact MCC to see if there can be some negotiation/compromise on "No Mow May". Cllrs were reminded of MCC's survey on "No Mow May

## 4.1To receive an update on the proposed markets on the site of the former Usk Household Recycling Centre

It was reported MCC Officers are unable to attend a meeting with UTC next week about the **(UHRC)**.

In the interim, UTC has been has advised MCC will need to consider internal uses of the UHRC land and if there are none, will invite bids/proposals from third parties over the use of the land. Apparently, MCC is obliged to comply with S123 which requires them to obtain best price for the asset.

MCC also stated they have not received any business case from UTC for consideration and needs to review its long-term intent for this land in terms of disposal or not. It was suggested UTC put forward a business case for use of the land.

**Resolved:** It is apparent UTC's business plan sent to MCC has been missed. Clerk to request a meeting with MCC.

### 4.2To receive an update on the Noise cameras

It was reported Gwent Police do not have noise detection equipment.

# 4.5 To review re-opening towns measures put in place in response to the Covid pandemic. Meeting scheduled for this coming Thursday.

A small group of councillors met to discuss key issues.

- a) Prohibition of parking on Castle Parade by the chip shop
- b) Application of "blip road markings "and a loading bay outside the One Stop Store in Maryport St.
- c) Flashing 20mph signs as motorists approach Bridge Street
- d) Widening of pavement along Bridge Street
- e) Improved signage on the A449 for HGVs
- f) Development of the former recycling centre
- g) Usk as a SMART Town
- h) Encouraging traffic coming off the A449 to turn left along Chepstow Road passed the Olway. This will prevent traffic going through Bridge St. & encourage visitors to drive through Usk.

**Resolved:** Following discussion it was resolved to remove item (h). The rest will be brought to the attention of MCC.
