Usk Town Council carried out a short 'snap-shot' survey of visitors to their stand at Usk Show on Saturday 10th September 2016.


There were 92 responses of which 67 were local residents or business owners and 25 were non-residents.

These are their responses:


N.B. they were not confined to one answer in each category or asked to prioritise.

- Social scene highlighted the pubs and restaurants, organisations and clubs and the wealth of events




The responses are mainly self-explanatory
